GLOBAL MISSIONS

WATER FOR GOOD

\$ 8,000

Water for Good's (formerly Life Water) mission is to provide clean water, sanitation, and hygiene to underserved communities, focusing on the needs of children. They work with local ministries to deliver sustainable solutions while sharing the gospel. Their approach combines practical help with spiritual care, aiming for long-term transformation in communities

This year we will be partnering with Water for Good to provide a community in the Central African Republic with new water access points.

AFRICA'S HOPE

\$ 4,000

Biblically trained leaders are the hope of Africa. Africa's Hope equips the African church to disciple nations through more than 380 Bible colleges and training programs, impacting over 23,000 emerging leaders.

Africa's Hope provides Bibles, complete with study notes in local languages, to Bible school students—an essential resource often unavailable to pastors and ministry students. Our goal is to provide 100 study Bibles to equip and empower leaders for ministry.





PRIORITY ONE

\$ 2,500

Priority One is dedicated to Christian leadership development through the building of Bible training centers around the world. They are committed to raising a new generation of leaders empowered to take the gospel to every nation, tribe, people, and language.

Our donation this year will help Priority One provide electricity to the Bible school in Burkina Faso, supporting its reopening after being closed by local pastors due to regional challenges.





GLOBAL TEEN CHALLENGE

\$ 5,000

Global Teen Challenge helps men, women, and children worldwide find freedom from life-controlling problems, reaching the hurting in schools, prisons, and neighborhoods to heal families and communities.

A 35-year dream became reality with the opening of Argentina's first recovery center, now serving the community. Leaders plan to open more centers, and this year, our donation will support these efforts.



BUILDERS INTERNATIONAL

\$ 8,000

Builders International collaborates with local leaders to create sustainable projects that share the gospel and address physical and spiritual needs. In southern Ecuador, the Jungle Bible School trains Shuar church planters to evangelize 600 unreached Amazonian villages. Development plans include dorms, a seminary, and professor housing.

We aim to raise funds to support this growing school, equipping students to lead and spread the Gospel.

MISSION OF HOPE IN HAITI

\$ 8,000

The Grace House is one of the few assisted living facilities in Haiti, created to meet the critical need for elderly care. Residents are provided with medical attention, daily assistance, and engaging activities in a safe and supportive environment. Along with essential care, there is a strong emphasis on creating opportunities for residents to encounter God and grow spiritually, ensuring holistic support for their physical and spiritual well-being.

This year our donation will go towards providing a yearly scholarship for 10+ residents to Grace House.



MISSION TRIP EXPENSES



Each year, Eagle Creek Church sends teams worldwide to impact the lives of the hurting and spiritually lost. Your giving helps cover staff and ministry project costs during these mission trips.

In 2025, we will travel to Ensenada, Mexico, to build a home for a family in need. In the Dominican Republic, we will help with minor church repairs and distribute water filtration systems to provide clean drinking water. Additionally, our teens will serve in Texas with Mission Arlington, meeting both physical and spiritual needs in the community.

PROJECT RESCUE

\$ 5,000

Project Rescue is a Christ-centered organization that rescues and restores survivors of sexual exploitation through safe homes, counseling, education, and vocational training. The new Honduras Project aims to establish a safe home for 20 girls, offering holistic care and spiritual mentorship. With plans to add vocational and education facilities, it brings hope and healing to vulnerable women and children.

We are partnering with the Honduras Project to support the completion of the safe home and empower survivors to rebuild their lives.

WYCLIFFE BIBLE TRANSLATOR

\$ 2,500

Clément, a Guley pastor, expressed “incredible joy” when the New Testament was translated into their language, as previous translations in French and Ngambay were difficult for many to understand. The New Testament has already transformed how the Guley engage with Scripture, and completing the Old Testament is expected to deepen their understanding of God’s character and redemptive plan. With only 10% of the population identifying as Christian, most people follow traditional religions. Church leaders believe having the full Bible will help address idolatry and social issues within the community.

Our goal is to support the translation of the entire Bible for the Guley church.





CONVOY OF HOPE

\$ 10,000

Convoy of Hope is a non-profit humanitarian and disaster relief organization that provides food, supplies, and humanitarian services to impoverished or otherwise vulnerable populations worldwide.

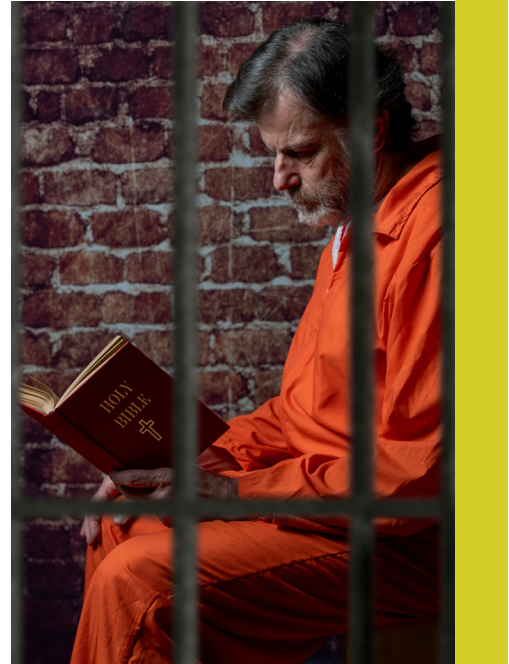
This year we will partner with Convoy of Hope to provide them with the necessary materials to continue their humanitarian and disaster relief work, where it is most needed.



FIGHT TO FORGIVE MINISTRIES \$ 5,000

Fight to Forgive is a ministry bringing the power of forgiveness to death row inmates and prisoners across the U.S. Through prison visits, workshops, and programs like Life+Wish, they help inmates overcome shame and bitterness, fostering lasting change in families and communities.

This year, our donation will support Fight to Forgive's efforts to disciple inmates, visit the incarcerated, and plant faith communities within some of the toughest prisons in the United States.

MARK & VICTORIA TURNEY

Mark and Victoria Turney are missionaries focused on spreading the gospel in Guinea-Conakry, a predominantly Muslim nation with a significant unreached population. With decades of experience in church planting and pastoral training across Africa, the Turneys are leading the first-ever AGWM missionary team in Guinea, supporting local leaders in their vision to plant 500 churches over the next decade.

JAMIE & TASHA KEMP

Jamie and Tasha have been missionaries in Indonesia, the largest Muslim country in the world since 2009. They are successfully pioneering a campus ministry that focuses on university students. By reaching the campus, they are impacting the future leaders of Indonesia.



TIM & SHARON THOMAS

Tim and Sharon serve as Care Coordinators for the Church Mobilization Dept. of US Missions. Their ministry consists of coaching, praying, and mentoring missionaries worldwide. They also assist missionaries in raising funds for projects, connecting church missions teams with missionaries, and working with rural churches throughout the US, helping encourage and guide them as needed.



MONTHLY MISSIONARY SUPPORT

JOEL & KAREN HOOBYAR

Joel and Karen serve in Indonesia, the fourth largest country in the world with nearly 100 Never Reached People Groups. They are stationed at SATI, the largest seminary in Indonesia. They believe that by training up the next generation of Christian leaders, the great task of establishing churches among the Never Reached can finally become a reality within their lifetime!



STEVE & KIM SOBEY

Steve and Kim Sobey have served as the National Directors for King's Castle Ministries in Nicaragua since 2009. Their goal is reach every child in Nicaragua with the Gospel by raising up an army of young, Spirit-filled warriors who will boldly declare that "Jesus saves and is coming soon." Under the Sobey's leadership, the ministry in Nicaragua has grown to over 160 local teams consisting of over 4,000 volunteers who are reaching their communities on a regular basis.

NATHAN & LISA TURNEY

Nathan and Lisa have been working in Asia Pacific since the mid-1990s. In 2020, they were assigned as the first AGWM missionaries to New Zealand. The Turneys are currently helping to plant a new multi-cultural church in Auckland with the hopes of reaching the lost and establishing a vibrant community of Christ followers.

TIM & TARYN HESMAN

Tim and Taryn are serving as local church planters right here in the Kansas City region. They are passionate about teaching and training people in the Word of God and doing life together as a body of believers.

KURT & STEPHANIE PLAGENHOEF

Kurt and Stephanie have been serving Albania and the Balkans since 1994 where 99% of the population are spiritually lost with no meaningful witness of the gospel. As director and co-director of BalkanREACH their goal is to reach the lost with the message of salvation, network with existing national churches and missionaries, and planting new churches.



COLIN & CORA DORSEY:

Colin, Cory, and their team are launching Students for Christ at the University of Luxembourg to reach students and inspire church planting in a nation where only 0.26% identify as Evangelical Christians. With backgrounds in pastoral ministry and teaching, they are deeply passionate about empowering young people to transform the world.

MILTON & JACKLYN LIMA

Milton and Jacklyn are missionaries in the Arab world, passionate about bringing the Gospel to unreached people. Partnering with a church-planting team, they grow house churches through discipleship and culturally sensitive outreach, trusting God to transform lives and establish His church.



BILLY & KATIE MELANSON

Billy and Katie are missionaries in the Arab World, sharing the gospel through daily interactions, relationships, and Billy's business-as-mission job. As part of the LiveDead initiative, they aim to reach the 99.9% without gospel access and help build a strong church in the Arab World.

JACOB & ERICA ZERGER

In 2013, the Zergers were appointed by an international mission organization to serve Arabs in the Middle East. Through living in the Middle East, Jacob and Erica learned firsthand about missionaries' many challenges and struggles when crossing cultures. In 2022, Jacob and Erica joined the One Another team where they assist in bringing healing to struggling missionaries by providing them a safe place to share and counseling them through various difficulties.

YOUTH WITH A MISSION KC (YWAM) \$ 8,000

YWAM Kansas City trains individuals, especially young people, for global missions, sharing Jesus' message and restoring New Testament principles to impact nations worldwide.

This year, we're partnering with YWAM KC to renovate "Westside," a student training building, with updates to flooring, carpeting, air conditioning, painting, and general maintenance.

KC GIRLS ACADEMY TEEN CHALLENGE

\$4,000

Kansas City Girls Academy is a Christ-centered therapeutic boarding school guiding girls to overcome challenges, embrace biblical truths, and discover their God-given purpose through discipleship, counseling, and transformative experiences.

Our partnership with the Girl's Academy will allow them to finish the construction of two new counseling spaces within their facility.



YTH CONFERENCE AND EKIDS VBS \$ 20,000

Students' lives are transformed at camps and conferences as they spend time worshipping Jesus and building relationships.

We provide scholarships and transportation for conferences, internships, and Kids Kraze VBS.



CHI ALPHA: UCM

\$ 5,000

Chi Alpha Campus Ministry shares the gospel with college students, raising disciples to transform campuses, impact communities, and change the world. The Rankins, U.S. missionaries, are pioneering Chi Alpha at the University of Central Missouri.

Through our financial support, we can help equip the Rankins to bring the hope of Christ to students of UCM.

This year's donation will support their efforts to provide food, clothing, and outreach through mobile distributions, community pantries, street outreaches, and events sharing the message of Jesus Christ.





AGAPE PAMOJA

\$ 8,000

Agape Pamoja is a volunteer-run non-profit organization that serves the multi-faceted needs of refugees from war-torn countries residing in Kansas City. They provide housing assistance, educational support, food, clothing, life skills, and other needs while doing life together.

This year, our goal is assist with the plumbing and wiring repairs of a new blessing house.



ELEOS COFFEE

\$ 5,000

Eleos serves homeless, trafficked, and addicted individuals with practical aid and the gospel of Jesus Christ. They support their community year-round through their coffeehouse, school supply drives, Bible studies, and food and clothing giveaways.

We aim to support Eleos by renovating their low-income apartments above the coffeehouse, providing help in the community.



CITY UNION MISSION

\$ 5,000



City Union Mission serves as the hands and feet of Jesus by providing thousands of men, women, and children struggling with homelessness and poverty a safe place to sleep, nutritious meals, and services such as vocational training.

This year, we want to support City Union Mission's greatest needs, including meals, shelter, and baby supplies and utility assistance.





HOPE HOUSE

\$2,500

Hope House serves women in greater Kansas City who experience domestic violence. They provide safe refuge and supportive services that educate and empower those impacted by domestic violence.

This year's donation will help Hope House provide shelter, therapy, and court advocacy for women and children.

NEW BEGINNINGS WOMENS CLINIC \$5,000

New Beginnings Women's Center is a pro-life ministry providing care and support for those experiencing unplanned or unsupported pregnancies.

Our donation to New Beginnings Clinic will help expand outreach to dads and enhance 24/7 online services for moms, addressing growing demand.
